Mel Kubicek Memorial Aviation Scholarship Application

A \$500 aviation scholarship can be awarded to a worthy applicant by EAA Chapter 227 of Waterloo, IA. The Mel Kubicek Memorial Scholarship Fund was created through the generosity of the late Mel Kubicek. Mel was a longtime member of Chapter 227, an avid Young Eagle pilot and an encouraging Flight Instructor. The scholarship will be awarded for the continuation of flight training at the Waterloo, Waverly or Independence Airports through their respective FBOs. The scholarship must be used within one year of the award.

Applicant Requirements:

- Age 25 years or less.
- Presently enrolled in school (high school, community college, college, or a trade school), or a graduate of the same.
- Successful completion of the private pilot written exam.
- Minimum of 5 hours solo (PIC) time in airplane, single-engine land, and the completion of a solo cross-country flight.

The application should be submitted in typewritten form. Please include a copy of your recent grade transcript (if applicable) and a copy of your logbook showing the prerequisite time. A written recommendation from your CFI is also recommended.
